RESOLUTION:

The state Government has decided to set up two new medical colleges at Rajkot and Bhavnagar. The Government of India has already given letter of intent for setting up the medical colleges. One of the conditions laid down for grant of permission to start the colleges is to provide the facility of teaching hospital to be attached to the new medical colleges.

These four hospitals in Rajkot which are to be used as the teaching hospitals namely; General Hospital, G.T. Sheth Eye Hospital, K.T. Children Hospital and R.Z. Hospital at Rajkot,; in Bhavnagar, Sir T. Hospital is to be used as teaching hospitals. These hospitals have total bed strength of 740 at Rajkot and a bed strength of 609 bed at Bhavnagar. The question of converting these hospitals into teaching hospitals was under consideration of the State Government.

2. Government is therefore, please to convert General Hospital, Rajkot along with G.T. Sheth Eye Hospital, K.T. Children Hospital and R.Z. Hospital Rajkot and Sir T. Hospital of Bhavnagar into teaching hospitals to be attached to new medical colleges at respective places.

3. Commissioner, Health will take all necessary consequential actions in the matter; like placement of staff, distribution of beds as per norms of MCI etc.
